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


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
Graphical Analysis

- 4. The green and red color bars prove the response are of free and fair, democratic and secular to put their ideas freely.


TEACHING, LEARNING, EVALUATION & RESEARCH



1. As the college admissions are online and adopted by online registration the students and colleges have free and secular access to the all sections of society.


- The responses indicate the resources and curriculum designed are students at the centre. The faculties are encouraged to



- 1. Taking first few responses together the college faculty meticulously completing the syllabus in each semester to the maximum efforts. However more need to be done by teachers.
- 2. The teaching faculties are reasonably prepared to teach but some faculty need to prepare, the suggestions to maintain study reference related reading for the delivery.
- 3. The teachers are establishing linkages to relate the content of the syllabus to real life situations, coordinate to real life situation. The cross cutting issues are linked with tribal life.
- 4. The studentswish the knowledge of the teacher to be presented to them. The teachers fair better in the knowledge.
- 5. The ICT used is lucrative but emerged advantageous with limited drawbacks and should promote teaching tools for e-content delivery and use of technology. ICT has been issue to deal with technically.
- 6. The student and grievance cell is less burdened and reasonably good and functional. The grievances are dealt with due hearing and promptly and justly.
- 7. The teachers are promoting field and exposure visits to the nearby study based areas for teaching and learning.

- 14. The institution performance is reasonably good and being in the tribal region. But much needs to be done in the regard so that a good image for overall development of the student to be catered.

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
